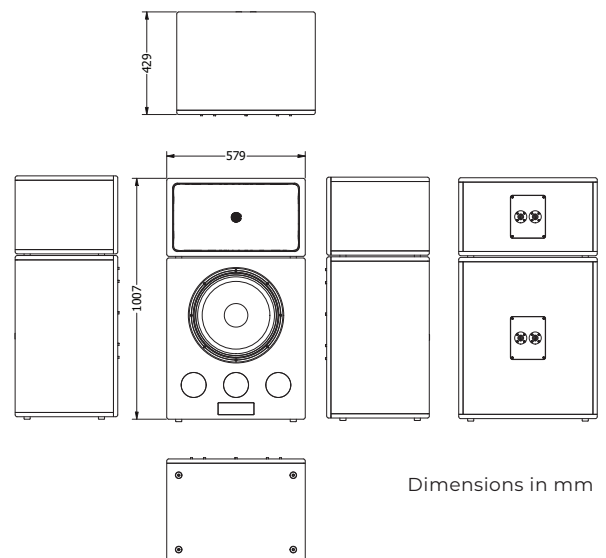
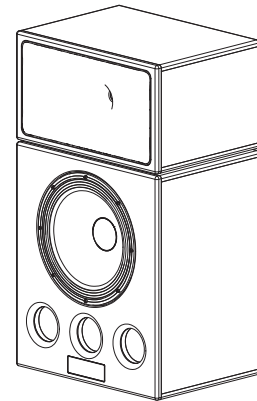

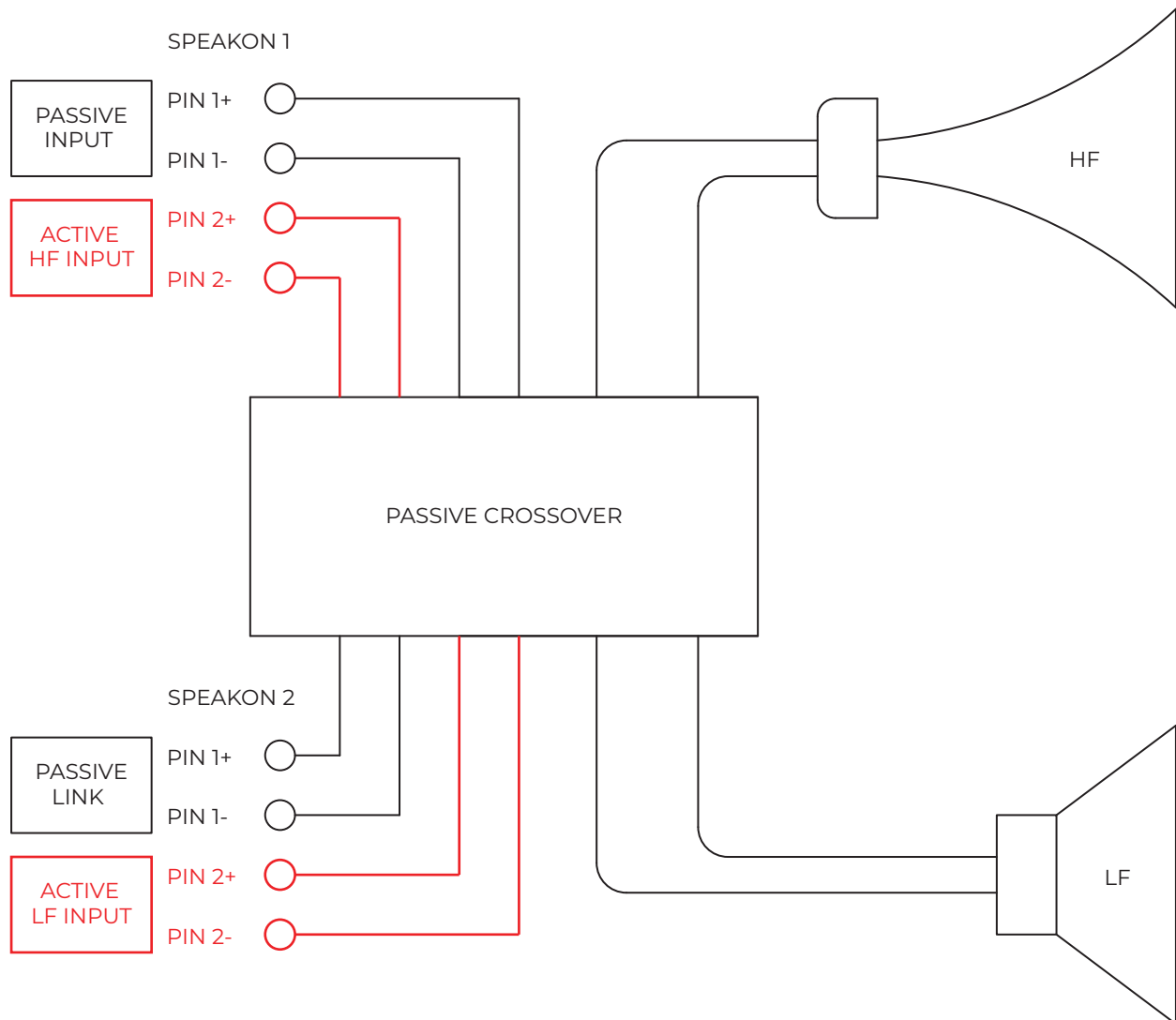

INTERNAL WIRING SCHEMATIC

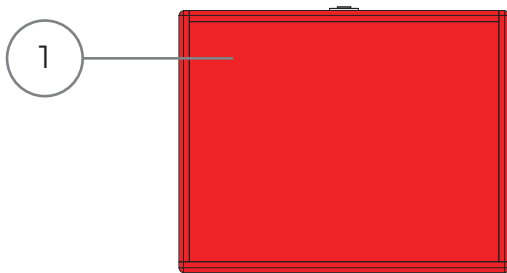

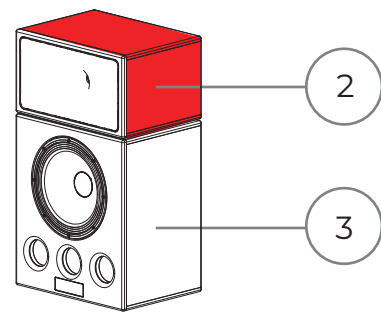

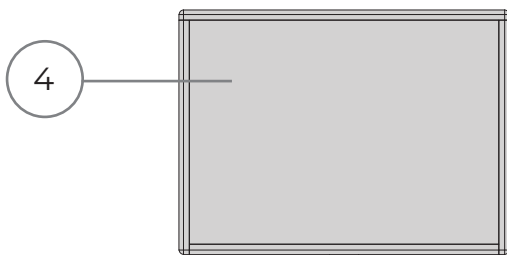

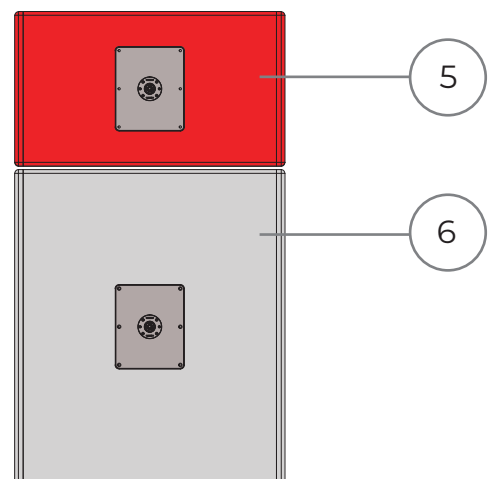
TOP VIEW

WARRANTY

Thank you for choosing the Epoch Series by Atomik. We take great pride in the quality and craftsmanship of our products. To ensure your satisfaction, we provide a comprehensive warranty that covers any manufacturing defects in materials or craftsmanship. Please review the details of our warranty policy to understand how we support you and your product over its lifespan.

1. Warranty Period

Atomik offers a 1-year limited warranty for all Epoch Series products, starting from the date of original purchase. This warranty applies to all manufacturing defects and guarantees that the product will function as intended during this period, provided that it is used according to the guidelines in this manual.

2. Warranty Validation

To validate your warranty, you must provide proof of purchase. The original receipt or invoice is required and must show the date of purchase and the authorized dealer where the product was purchased. Warranty claims without this documentation may not be accepted.

3. Transferability of Warranty

The Epoch Series warranty is transferable to a subsequent owner during the warranty period. However, the warranty period will not be extended beyond the original 1-year coverage from the date of purchase. If you sell or transfer ownership of the product, the new owner will inherit the remaining warranty period, provided they also provide the original proof of purchase.

4. Coverage Details

During the warranty period, Atomik will, at its sole discretion, repair or replace any product or parts found to be defective in materials or workmanship. Warranty repairs or replacements will be carried out at no cost to the customer, except for the shipping costs associated with returning the product for service. Products must be shipped prepaid in their original packaging to an authorized Atomik service center or distributor.

5. Exclusions and Limitations

This warranty covers only defects in materials and craftsmanship. It does not cover the following:

- **Unauthorized Modifications:** Any modification or repair performed by a third party not authorized by Atomik will void this warranty.
- **Improper Use:** Damage or failure resulting from improper use, misuse, or use not in accordance with the guidelines in this manual.
- **Negligence or Accidents:** Any damage caused by neglect, accidents, mishandling, or misuse by the user, including physical damage, dropping, or impact.
- **Environmental Exposure:** Exposure to extreme conditions such as inclement weather, excessive heat, humidity, or moisture can damage the product and is not covered under this warranty.
- **Acts of God:** Natural events such as lightning, floods, earthquakes, or other acts of God.
